

Program That Teaches Garbage Sorting Procedures and Disposal Rules

- $\odot~$ City employees will inspect garbage bags and other items disposed of that are in violation of sorting/disposal rules.

Sorting Garbage / Disposal Rules

(1) Sort your garbage prior to disposal.

- (2) Take your garbage to the designated garbage station in your neighborhood.
- (3) Take your garbage out early in the morning (by 8:00) on the designated collection day.

(4) Dispose of garbage using designated bags/containers.
