

Program That Teaches Garbage Sorting Procedures and Disposal Rules

Although many people observe the garbage disposal rules and carefully strive to sort garbage, such as miscellaneous paper, there are still many city residents and businesses who do not follow the basic rules for sorting and disposing of garbage. Therefore, city ordinances have been revised, and a program that teaches garbage sorting procedures and disposal rules has been established.



This program is carried out in the following stages:

Inspection	Instruction	Warning	Order	Penalty, Etc.
City employees inspect garbage bags and other items that are left uncollected.	Those who failed to follow the garbage sorting/disposal rules are given proper instruction.	If the rules are not followed even after instruction, a warning to improve is given.	If the rules are not followed even after the warning, an order to improve is given.	If the rules are not followed a year after the order was given, a “non-penal fine” is imposed*.

*If a business establishment is in violation, the name and other information of the said establishment will be made public as well.

- Warning, orders, penalties, and other actions will become effective as of April 1, 2011.
- This program applies to those who are capable of sorting garbage but do not try to do so or do not follow disposal rules.
- City employees will inspect garbage bags and other items disposed of that are in violation of sorting/disposal rules.

Sorting Garbage /Disposal Rules

- (1) Sort your garbage prior to disposal.
- (2) Take your garbage to the designated garbage station in your neighborhood.
- (3) Take your garbage out early in the morning (by 8:00) on the designated collection day.
- (4) Dispose of garbage using designated bags/containers.
